Universal Free School Meals

We are pleased to see that many of you have been taking advantage of Universal Primary Free School meals, now that it has been rolled out to all primary school children in Wrexham.

Now your child has been back in school for a few weeks, we wanted to let you know that you are able to book your child's meal three weeks in advance and we hope this makes easier for you. To avoid disappointment, here are a couple of changes that you need to remember:

- orders need to be placed by 8am
- the list of children who have ordered a school meal cannot be updated after 8am so if you haven't ordered a meal, your child will need to bring a packed lunch

Please do remember to ensure you order your children's lunches in advance as we are now unable to order on the day and we do have to contact home for a packed lunch to be brought to school. Thank you for your cooperation.

October Half Term - Holiday Club

Bookings for October Half Term Holiday Club will close at 10am on Friday 20th October 2023.

Please do make sure you book your places in advance as spaces are filling up quickly and we don't want anyone to miss out on their place.

Bookings must be made online using the online booking and payment system and payment made at the time of booking unless using the 30 Hour Childcare offer to pay for your child's place.



Moodly

We have been delighted with the launch of the Moodly system at school this week. The system is used informally on a daily basis to track pupils' wellbeing and allow timely intervention where needed. We have launched this in Year 5 and 6 and will be rolling out to our other classes over the next week or so.

One emerging, early trend from analysing the information from Moodly is that many children are feeling tired when they come to school in the morning. Of course, we all know the importance of healthy sleep routines, but this information allows us to make a timely reminder to ensure children go to sleep early and that they have device free time before going to sleep. 


