Pupils have been studying Welsh castles and we are learning to draw and paint castles in Expressive Arts using watercolours

Pupils have been working in small groups to devise their own science investigations. They have been looking at suitable properties of materials to make a castle drawbridge. 


TECTONIC PLATE BOUNDARIES


