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Blwyddyn 5 & 6 - Lifesaving Skills Session

We welcomed Jess Gould to school this week, she is a resuscitation officer, to deliver a session on life saving skills to the three classes. The children found out what to do in a medical emergency, including calling 999 and asking nearby adults for help, looking to see if a patient is breathing, using the recovery position, CPR and mouth to mouth resuscitation for adults, children and babies. The children also had a turn at using the defibrillator (not a real, live one!) The children were fantastic, listening and responding sensibly and asked some excellent questions. A really valuable session – thank you Jess!

Pupils in Year 1 and 2 have been painting in the style of Vincent Van Gogh, particularly imitating the colours, swirls and broken lines in Starry Night.




