

Pupils have been busy as part of our VE Day celebrations taking part in lots of craft activities



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
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Derbyn - Literacy and Numeracy

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Blwyddyn 5 & 6 - Cymru


Year 5 and 6 have been learning about places in Wales. They have made an interactive map showing all a range of places following their visit to Wrexham recently.
