Dear parents and carers,

The weather has certainly brought us challenge this week, but I have been very proud and impressed with how well the pupils continued to engage so well in their learning, and especially during **transition day** on Thursday. It is a busy time of year in school as we reflect on the successes of the year, and begin to think of our aspirations for the new school year. One way we do this is through an in-depth analysis of pupils' progress across all Areas of Learning and Experience. Later in July, you will receive your child's end of year school report via the **My Child at School app**. This will be the only method used to issue school reports this year, so please do ensure you are able to access the app and can use this. Our records do show all parents and carers signed to the app now, which we are very grateful for.

Our **attendance** is improving again after a series of term-time holidays caused a recent dip. Unfortunately, a few pupils are still **arriving late** for school on an almost daily basis. This is despite us issuing reminder letters and speaking with parents and carers. We are now moving these cases to the Local Authority Attendance Service to support us in ensuring all pupils arriving at school on time. Whilst we know and understand lateness can occur from time to time, the small number arriving late regularly is causing concern.

These events are for pupils only this year, but we plan to open them to parent and carer spectators next year.

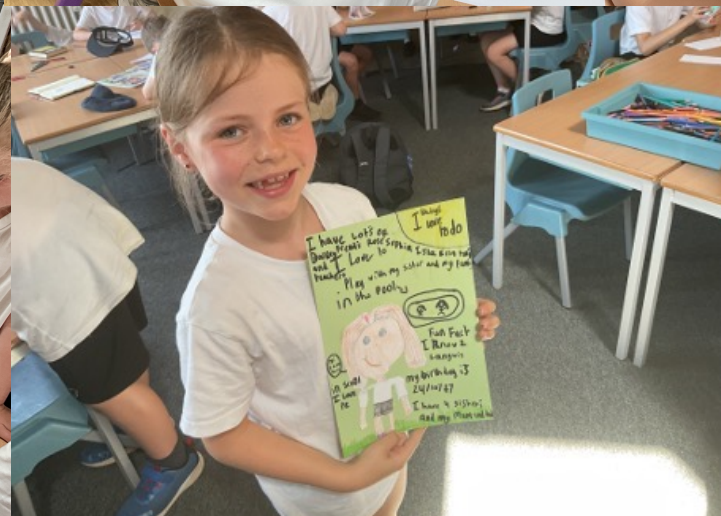

We keep a close focus on attendance and ensuring pupils attend school as often and as punctually as possible. You can see trends and patterns over the year below.



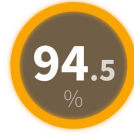
Attendance Week to Date

For All Pupils



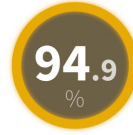
Attendance Month to Date
