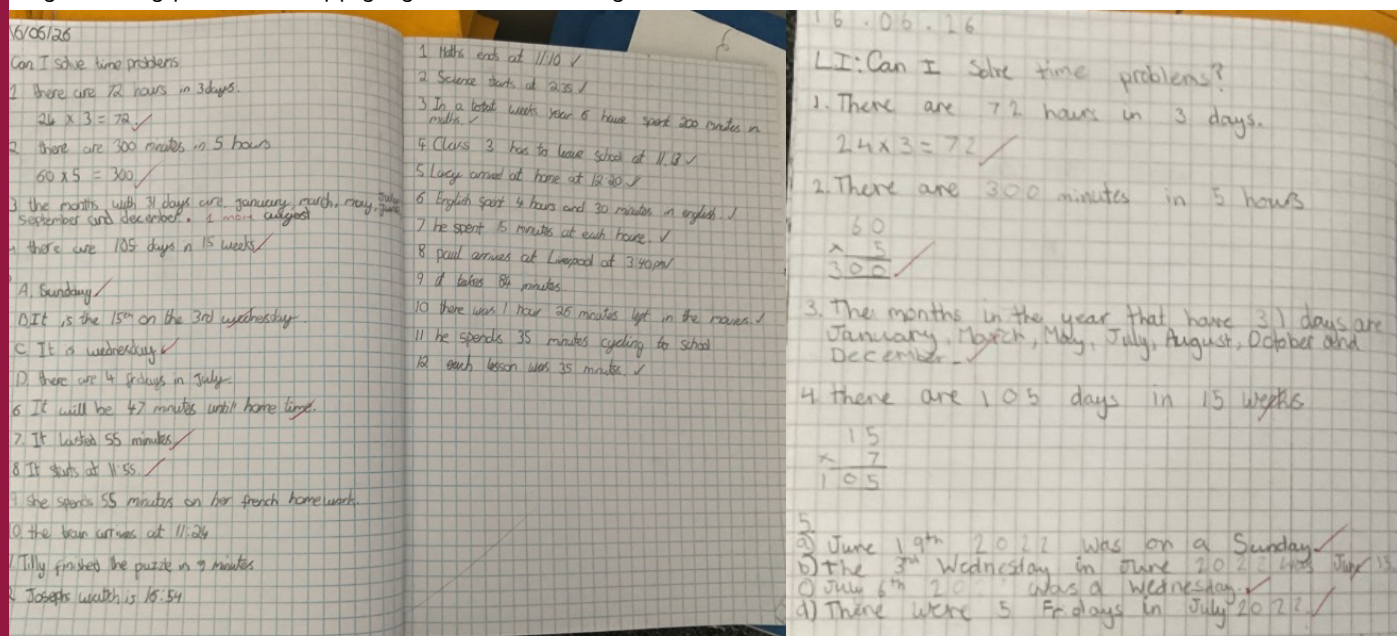

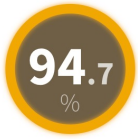

We keep a close focus on attendance and ensuring pupils attend school as often and as punctually as possible. You can see trends and patterns over the year below.



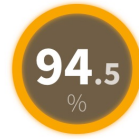
**Attendance Week to Date**

For All Pupils



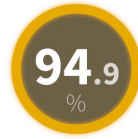
**Attendance Month to Date**
