They also wrote a comment on his work on his fact file.


The children have followed along with his live painting sessions and had the opportunity to use the material he uses.  
Have half of the image to try and replicate including the detail.

Children will use his images to inspire them.  
They planned which one they want to use as a base. The children will state what they will borrow and be inspired by.  
They then discussed what they have changed.

Children completed their sketches and used the materials they have planned to use.  
(Pencil, felt tips, pastels).

Children reflected on their creations and shared them with their table to see others work. Then shared what they liked about their peers' creations.  
Children wrote 2 stars of what they like about their own and an even better if to show how they can move their creations forward next time.




## Respond



Children responded to his artwork by stating if they liked them or if they didn't like them and why.


They used a range of mediums to explore his use of colour.
