

Cynllun Tymor – Termly Plan

Blwyddyn 1/2 - Tymor Gwanwyn – Summer Term

Victorian Postcard– Cerdyn Post Fictoriadd
We will be studying Victorians, asking and answering questions about the past.

Language, Literacy & Communication

Pupils will have opportunities to develop their understanding of instructions to make Victorian toys and baking. They will look at the conventions of the writing and being able to write their own. The children will be immersed in a range of poetry and prose based on Victorians and Victorian experiences. Children will write about the darkness of mines, the noise of factories and the smell of steam trains and build their poems from experiences.

Mathematics & Numeracy

Pupils will focus on measures including length, weight and capacity. They will then move on to focussing on fractions as equal parts, $\frac{1}{2}$, $\frac{1}{4}$'s of shapes and amounts. Pupils will learn how to tell the time to the nearest 5 minutes, reading analogue and digital times. They will also have the opportunity to understand timed events in order. Pupils will collect data, produce tally charts, block graphs and pictograms. The pupils will also learn about position and direction, and move on to symmetry and rotations.

Science & Technology

We will focus on light and sound through the Victorians. We will investigate which materials conduct electricity and which are insulators. Pupils will find out about the invention of the lightbulb by Edison and Latimer. The children will investigate how sound is made and how it travels, through the invention of the telephone. The pupils will also learn about push and pull through Victorian toys and investigate how trains move using steam.

Humanities

Pupils will find out about real-life heroes in our community and celebrate local heroes. We will use enquiry questions to develop children's independence skill. We will research Welsh superheroes and respond to stories about them. Children will look at real life careers and we hope to visit the local Fire Station.

RVE

Through the 'Journey of life' sub lens, children will begin to recognise that people have personal life stories and start to tell their own life story. We will begin to recognise what makes people special and how people are different. We will consider our school values of Courage and Forgiveness. We will also look at the Easter story

Expressive Arts

Pupils will consider the work of Charles Rene Mackintosh and LS Lowry. They will learn about the artists, focus on how the art is produced and evaluate the styles before trying to produce their own art in the style of these artists. The pupils will also learn to compose rhythmic patterns inspired by machinery. To create soundscapes of steam trains. Roll play the Victorian classroom

Health & Wellbeing

Pupils will work on their athletic skills in preparation for sports day. They will also take part in team sports, learning communication skills to work as a team member. Pupils will consider the skills needed to work well in a team. During our My Happy mind and KIVA sessions, we will look at the Relate module. We will discuss fairness and rights of children.

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
