Sports Day 2023

School Meals – Parent Pay

We have seen a big increase in the number of pupils accessing school meals over recent weeks which we are pleased about. Unfortunately, we have also seen an increase in parents and carers not ordering meals on Parent Pay.

All pupils accessing school meals, be them free school meals or paid for, are required to have their meal ordered on Parent Pay. Meals can be booked up to two weeks in advance and up to 8am on the day that the meal is due to be taken.

It is currently planned that all full-time pupils from Reception to Year 6 will be able to access a free school meal from September 2023. We will keep you updated as further information on this is received.

There is no need to book a place, please feel free to turn up for an informal discussion and opportunity to hear of developments planned for 2023/24! We look forward to seeing you there!



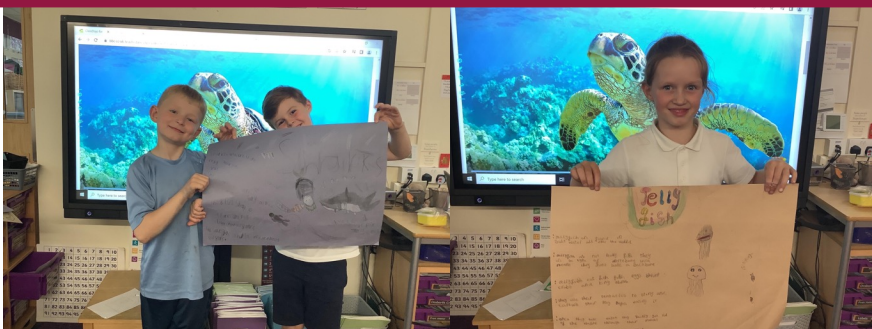
