Public Health update

I am sure that you will have heard of the tragic news this week of a child passing away in South Wales as a result of streptococcal disease. There has been an increase in Wales in figures and Public Health Wales continue to monitor this closely. We have been asked to keep a close watch in school and follow Public Health Wales advice. We have also been asked to share the following important actions with parents and carers:

- Parents/carers of unwell children should be advised to seek medical advice for diagnosis and treatment
- **A person with scarlet fever should withdraw** from your setting for **24 hours** after the commencement of appropriate antibiotic treatment
- Good hand hygiene and avoidance of spread of respiratory secretions (as per influenza- "catch it, bin it, kill it") can help to prevent the spread of infection
