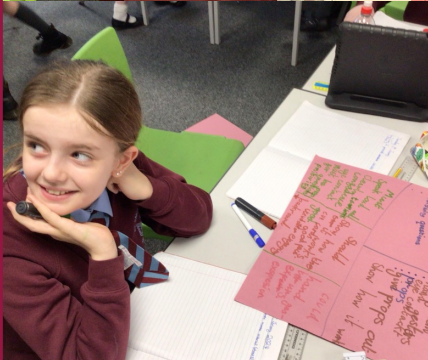
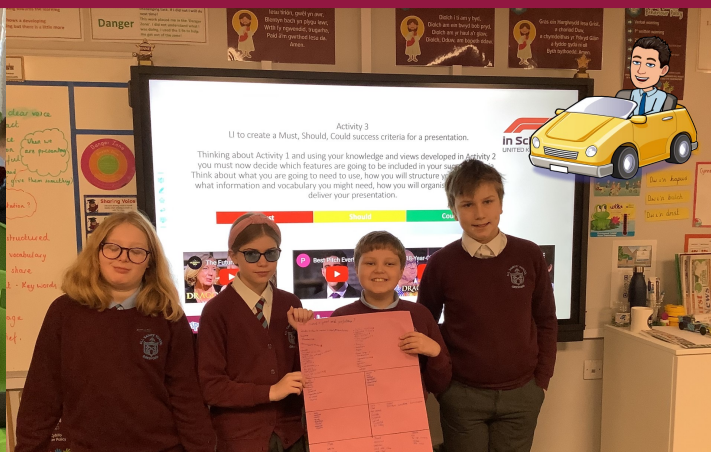

F1 in Schools

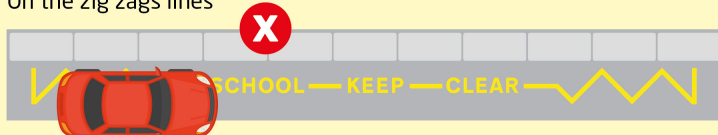

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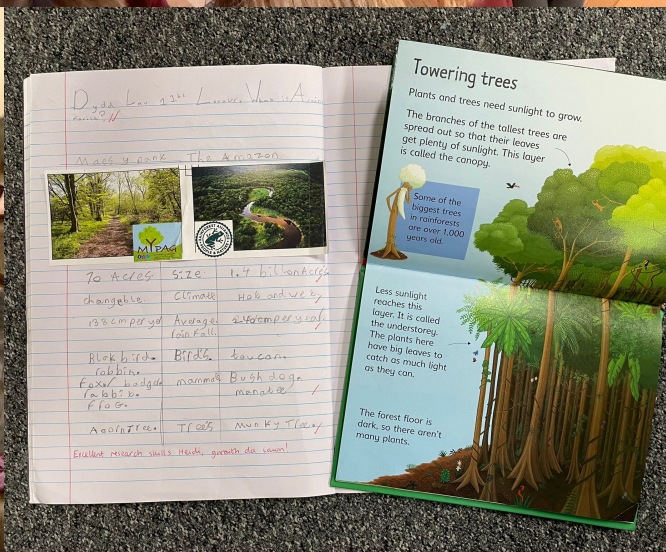
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Year 3/4 - Rainforests
