






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## Understanding Data - Year 3/4

- orders need to be placed by 8am
- the list of children who have ordered a school meal cannot be updated after 8am so if you haven't ordered a meal, your child will need to bring a packed lunch.

Sadly, we still are receiving communication in relation to dangerous inconsiderate parking, reporting such matters to the police and can only encourage you to do the same.





Tickets available via Parent Pay of cash on the evening.














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#### Year 6 - Silent Debate


