
School Admissions


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Harvest Service

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Universal Free School Meals

Now your child has been back in school for a few weeks, we wanted to let you know that you are able to book your child's meal three weeks in advance and we hope this makes easier for you. To avoid disappointment, here are a couple of changes that you need to remember:

- orders need to be placed by 8am
- the list of children who have ordered a school meal cannot be updated after 8am so if you haven't ordered a meal, your child will need to bring a packed lunch

Please do remember to ensure you order your children's lunches in advance as we are now unable to order on the day and we do have to contact home for a packed lunch to be brought to school. Thank you for your cooperation.





First Aid - Year 5 and 6

Jess is a Resuscitation Officer at the Countess of Chester Hospital and kindly donated her time to come and support enriching our curriculum. The sessions were part of a link between the British heart Foundation and Resus Council UK, delivering the Restart a Heart programme which aims to education and engage communities in life saving skills. It was a delight to welcome Jess into school and in speaking with pupils following the sessions, know that they took a huge amount from their work.

Pupils in Year 3 and 4 have been busy exploring the work of Martyn Evans. They have been making 3D models of the village!
















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Year 5 – Language, Literacy & Communication




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




Year 5 - Mathematics

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Parent/Carer Drop-ins


