Traffic & Parking

Operation Encompass

Our school is part of Operation Encompass which is a national scheme that operates jointly between schools and police forces. Operation Encompass is the reporting to schools, prior to the start of the next school day, when a child or young person has experienced domestic abuse.

As a school we have ensured that a member of our staff, (Designated Safeguarding Lead) known as a Key Adult, has been trained in the Operation Encompass procedures allowing us to then use the information that has been shared, in confidence, to support the child/ren in our care. The Domestic Abuse Act 2021 identifies children who experience domestic abuse as victims of domestic abuse in their own right.

Where school has been informed of an Operation Encompass referral, Mrs Edwards, School Wellbeing Manager, will make contact home to determine any support that maybe required. We are keen to offer the best support possible to all our pupils and we believe this will be extremely beneficial for all those involved.

Parent Pay

Ensuring that Parent Pay accounts do not carry any debt is essential, please do check your account regularly to ensure payments to school are up to date. We strive to give as much notice as possible for any school visits to allow payment plans to be taken advantage of and to ensure payments are made in good time. Should you require any support in relation to Parent Pay, please contact the main school office. Activation letters for those new to school are being sent home today, if you don't receive one, please email mailbox@allsaints-pri.wrexham.sch.uk and we wil forward another copy. Those pupils attending morning Nursery will receive their letters tomorrow.

Universal Free School Meals

The roll out of Universal Free School Meals has taken place today for pupils in Reception – Year 6. The Local Authority systems used to order dinners are being updated at present and we are hopeful that ordering will commence from tomorrow. It is essential that with over 300 pupils to cater for that choices are ordered on Parent Pay by 8am on the day the meal is due to be taken. There is option to also order up to two weeks in advance.
