- Posting anonymous messages and forwarding chain letters is forbidden.
- As e-mail can be forwarded or inadvertently be sent to the wrong person, the same levels of language and content should be applied as for letters or other media that would be suitable for viewing by a child.
- Use of the network to access inappropriate materials such as pornographic, racist or offensive material is forbidden.
- Staff should not use 'work', the school or its pupils (or any other comments which may relate to All Saints' V.A. School School) on personal social media sites such as 'Facebook'.
- The ICT equipment provided can be recalled by the school at any time.
- Any loss or damage to equipment will be charged to the person who is using the equipment away from the school site and who has signed the agreement below.
