<u>leithoedd, Llythrennedd a Chyfathrebu /</u> Languages, Literacy and Communication

Pupils will listen to and retell the story of 'Supertato' in the style of a diary entry. They will focus on punctuation, descriptive language, time connectives, adverbs and feelings. Pupils will also learn about reallife superheroes and write persuasively in the form of a job advert. Pupils will also develop on their performance and oracy skills by hot-seating, using digital media and green screen technology. We will continue our work on presentation and handwriting.

Addysg Grefyddol / Religious Education

Through the 'Journey of life' sub lens, children will begin to recognise that people have personal life stories and start to tell their own life story. We will begin to recognise what makes people special and how people are different. We will consider our school values of Courage and Forgiveness. We will also look at the Easter story.

<u>Dyniaethau /</u>

<u>Humanities</u>

Pupils will find out about real-life heroes in our community and celebrate local heroes. We will use maps to identify where we would find them in our area. We will research Welsh superheroes, respond to stories about them, and place their key life events on a timeline.

<u>Mathemateg a Rhifedd /</u> <u>Mathematics and Numeracy</u>

Pupils will focus on recognising coins and adding amounts of money, finding change from a given amount, and will begin to learn how to budget. They will be given opportunities to apply these skills in real-life contexts. We will continue our work on multiplication and division using TT Rockstars and Numbots. We will also measure length and height to the nearest cm and m. Through problem-solving activities, pupils will measure and record mass, capacity & temperature.

<u>Iechyd a Lles /</u> <u>Health and Well-being</u>

Pupils will work on their striking and catching skills through the sport of Kinball. They will also understand the rules and consider position and movement. Pupils will consider the skills needed to work well in a team. During our My Happy mind and KIVA sessions, we will look at 'appreciate' and 'relate'.

Pupils will use the phrases 'Oes gen ti? / Mae gen i..' We will learn the names of clothing, body parts and ask 'wyt ti'n hoffi..?' in relation to different foods. We will sing and perform in Welsh during our school Eisteddfod.

<u>Gwyddoniaeth a Thechnoleg /</u> <u>Science and Technology</u>

We will look at how we have changed from birth and how we change as we get older. We will look carefully at our bodies and collect data such as head size, hand size and foot size. Pupils will investigate their heart through exercise and will plan a healthy picnic. We will explore the properties of different materials using a range investigations linked to superhero clothing, such as absorbing and flexibility. Children will consolidate their science investigative skills to design and make their own vegetable superhero. We will use Common Sense Media to become healthy digital citizens.

Y Celfyddydau Mynegiannol / Expressive Arts

Pupils will consider the work of Roy Lichtenstein to create comic strip-style artwork and produce cityscape art. We will use greenscreen technology to perform as superheroes and explore different sounds. We will also learn a superhero dance and listen and appraise superhero music. We will perform in our school Eisteddfod and celebrate Dydd Miwsig Cymru.

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
