

Ieithoedd, Llythrennedd a Chyfathrebu / Languages, Literacy and Communication

Using the Gresford Mining Disaster and our locality as a focus the pupils will develop their writing skills to produce an empathic piece in the role of someone else. They will also be using drama techniques to act out the timeline of events during the disaster. The pupils will be designing a questionnaire to complete a survey based on a local issue. They will use the results from this to create a digital infographic and verbally present their findings.

Iechyd a Lles / Health and Well-being

Pupils will discuss the importance of making good first impressions when settling in to their new class and how to approach any challenges they face. Through KiVa lessons, pupils will learn about how healthy relationships are fundamental to our well-being. They will plan and prepare a basic nutritious meal favoured by miners. The pupils will hopefully visit the Miners' Rescue Station and take part in the physical methods used to train the rescue miners. The pupils will be identifying risks and steps to reduce them through conducting risk assessments.

Cymraeg / Welsh

The pupils will study the book Wncwl Em. They will revise patterns of how to speak in the first person and how to introduce other people. Within our topic lessons pupils will give directional instructions in Welsh. They will also share opinions on food.

Mathemateg a Rhifedd / Mathematics and Numeracy

This term the pupils will develop their understanding of place value and the four operations. Following this the pupils will learn to calculate mean, median, mode and range to compare data and choose the most appropriate average. Using the local issue identified as a stimulus, the pupils will focus on collecting, representing and interpreting data in a variety of ways. The pupils will then use their measuring skills to measure the distance of journeys and to predict and record the time these journeys take.

Gwyddoniaeth a Thechnoleg / Science and Technology

During this term, the pupils will investigate solids, liquids and gases. Pupils will investigate changes of state: how solids can turn to a liquid etc. They will also identify flammable and inflammable materials using the camp fire in the forest schools area. They will learn about natural materials and why they have been processed to make them useful. They will manipulate data into a visual form.

Addysg Grefyddol / Religious Education

The pupils' RE work will focus on the significance of belonging in people's lives, different communities and social groups. As part of their work, the pupils will write prayers in memory of those who sadly passed away. Our half term value is 'Generosity'.



Dyniaethau / Humanities

The pupils will be learning about the Gresford Mining Disaster and place the events in chronological order. They will use appropriate methods to gather information and then interpret the information through the context of the enquiry question. The pupils will present their findings in a variety of ways and make judgements based on the evidence found. They will show an understanding of how factors and events from the past have shaped the community.

Y Celfyddydau Mynegiannol / Expressive Arts

We will study the work of local artist, Largeys, to create some emotive work on the Gresford Mining Disaster. The pupils will also learn how to relief print using disciplined specific techniques to create their work.

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
