

Ieithoedd, Llythrennedd a Chyfathrebu /
Languages, Literacy and Communication

Children will focus on developing their instructional writing skills. They will plan, draft and edit their own instructions on mummification. The poetry focus will be on limericks where the children will follow the syllable pattern to write their own based on the work of Ada Lovelace. They will use their computer skills to present their work digitally.

Using the voyages of Columbus and Prince Madoc as inspiration, the children will plan, draft and edit a fictional diary entry using descriptive language to convey feeling and emotions.

Iechyd a Lles /
Health and Well-being

Children will explore their own styles of learning, consider barriers to learning and ways they can be overcome. They will consider determination and resilience and how these are vital in going for goals. They will explore how people in history have overcome a challenge to change the way we live our lives today. In PE, children will be taught dynamic balance and agility as well as static balance through a wide range of activities. They will focus on social skills such as guiding a group and giving feedback.

Cymraeg /
Welsh

The children will learn vocabulary for the human body, clothes & food this term. They will also learn how to follow & give directions. Revision of language patterns will take place through Helpwr Heddiw sessions.

Mathemateg a Rhifedd /
Mathematics and Numeracy

This term the children will learn about 2D & 3D shapes & nets. They will develop their understanding of multiplication & division. They will also learn co-ordinates & angles and length & perimeter. Work on money & giving change will also be covered this term.

Addysg Grefyddoll /
Religious Education

The children's RE work will focus on the Christian story of creation and how this compares to similar stories in other faiths. They will form their own questions and opinions on creation. They will look at the contribution to life from Jesus and other people in history. The Easter story will be explored in detail.

Gwyddoniaeth a Thechnoleg /
Science and Technology

During this term, the children will learn through practical activities and research the functions of the human skeleton, muscles and major organs. They will investigate the importance of a balanced diet and discover the impact of not eating well and the impact this had on people in the past.

Children will look at the work of Benjamin Franklin and learn about electricity and its uses in the modern world. They will investigate and make electrical circuits using a variety of components. They will learn the symbols for electrical components and will predict and test if certain circuits will work or not. The children will use their digital skills to present information about electrical safety in the home.

Darganfyddiadau Rhyfeddol
Amazing Discoveries

Dyniaethau /
Humanities

Children will learn about people who have made amazing discoveries: Howard Carter & the tomb of Tutankhamun; Rosalind Franklin & the discovery of DNA; Ada Lovelace & the discovery of computer programming; Christopher Columbus & Prince Madoc & the discovery of America. Children will have opportunity to guide their learning throughout the topic.

Y Celfyddydau Mynegiannol /
Expressive Arts

The children will look at Egyptian artwork and use this to inspire their own work to create a death mask and a cartouche using hieroglyphics. They will explore the use of line by creating Zentangles. Using Columbus and Madoc's voyages, they will create maps plotting the journeys made. To do this they will use water colour washes and sketches to add details. The children will listen to and appraise 'Prince Madoc' by Don Woods before performing in a choir themselves.

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
