**Languages, Literacy and Communication**

The children will then move on to focusing on Duffy the Sea Turtle. The main focus of this will be non-chronological reports, recycling, plastic pollution, persuasive adverts and non-fiction writing.

**Iechyd a Lles /**  
**Health and Well-being**

We will be focussing on New Beginnings in Health and Well-being, this will help the class get to know each other, exploring and managing feelings and setting goals for the year ahead.

We will also be focusing on healthy eating, looking at where our food comes from and designing, making and evaluating a healthy meal.

**Cymraeg /**  
**Welsh**

We will be looking at information about themselves and their family, they will be using descriptive language to develop their sentence structure.

We will also be looking at the types of weather and writing and presenting a weather report

**Mathemateg a Rhifedd /**  
**Mathematics and Numeracy**

This term the children will focus on number and the number system and place value before moving on to addition, subtraction, multiplication and division. They will use a range of methods to solve different types of problems.

**Addysg Grefyddoll /**  
**Religious Education**

To understand that people have many different relationships and to explore Christian's relationships with God. Being aware of their connections between their own lives and the natural world and living things.

**Gwyddoniaeth a Thechnoleg /**  
**Science and Technology**

During this term, the children will investigate materials and their properties, what materials are best for specific jobs for example waterproofing, insulating. The children will also be focussing on recycling and composting. What materials can be recycled? What happens to materials that can't be recycled?

After half term we will be looking at help our habitats, this will focus on animal adaptations and climate change including the greenhouse effect and what we can do to help the environment.

We will begin the first half term with a study of rivers in Wales and our locality. We will look at the features of rivers and discuss the pollution problems surrounding them. **Expressive Arts**

In music we will be focusing on Handel's Water Music, listening, appraising and producing graphic scores. We will then use this to create a piece of dance.
