

Ieithoedd, Llythrennedd a Chyfathrebu / Languages, Literacy and Communication

Pupils will have opportunities to develop their understanding of non-chronological reports. They will immerse themselves in these texts and discover the different elements that make them up. They will concentrate on using formal language, captions and technical vocabulary. The pupils will also focus on newspapers and how news is reported in the modern day. The children will learn about the past tense and the importance of research. The pupils will also have chance to role-play a Victorian child.

Addysg Grefyddol / Religious Education

Pupils will be studying through the lense of Authority and influence. The pupils will begin to recognise that they are influenced by some important people, and that this affects how they feel, think and behave. The pupils will begin to identify Christian leaders and their roles in church and faith communities. They will also look at other faith and non-faith communities. They will also begin to identify important people in the bible and how they influenced others.

Dyniaethau / Humanities

Pupils will find out about the Victorians. They will begin to learn about how history has influenced today and what inventions we still use and have developed from the discovery in Victorian times. The pupils will also take part in a local study using the Census from the High Street in Gresford. The pupils will focus on our school in Victorian Times, leading up to its 150th anniversary. The pupils will learn about the role of children and schooling and complete a visit to Blists Hill Victorian Town.

Mathemateg a Rhifedd / Mathematics and Numeracy

Pupils will focus on measures including length, weight and capacity. They will then move on to focussing on fractions as equal parts, $\frac{1}{2}$, $\frac{1}{4}$'s of shapes and amounts. Pupils will learn how to tell the time to the nearest 5 minutes, reading analogue and digital times. They will also have the opportunity to understand timed events in order. Pupils will collect data, produce tally charts, block graphs and pictograms. The pupils will also learn about position and direction, and move on to symmetry and rotations.

Iechyd a Lles / Health and Well-being

Pupils will work on their athletic skills using the Olympics as a theme. They will also take part in team sports, learning communication skills to work as a team member. Pupils will consider the skills needed to work well in a team. During our My Happy mind and KIVA sessions, we will look at the Relate module.

Cymraeg / Welsh

The pupils will focus on Welsh using the Victorians as inspiration. They will learn the commands of a strict Victorian Headmaster, following a timetable, role play events and also taking part in Helpwr Heddiw sessions.

Gwyddoniaeth a Thechnoleg / Science and Technology

We will focus on light and sound through the Victorians. We will investigate which materials conduct electricity and which are insulators. Pupils will find out about the invention of the lightbulb by Edison and Latimer. The children will investigate how sound is made and how it travels, through the invention of the telephone. The pupils will also learn about living things and their habitats, focussing on plants and animals. Pupils will look at what plants need to survive and carry out experiments to further their scientific understanding. The pupils will also look at animal's homes and food chains.

Y Celfyddydau Mynegiannol / Expressive Arts

Pupils will consider the work of Charles Rene Mackintosh and LS Lowry. They will learn about the artists, focus on how the art is produced and evaluate the styles before trying to produce their own art in the style of these artists. The pupils will also learn Victorian dances and use drama techniques to plan and perform their own puppet show.

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
