

**Ieithoedd, Llythrennedd a Chyfathrebu /
Languages, Literacy and Communication**

Using Wrexham as the focus, pupils will be writing a script for a tourism information video as a 'Welcome to Wrexham' for tourists. They will then use their script, as well as their research from the field trip to Wrexham, to create their own persuasive / informative video. The aim of the video will be to attract more tourism to the local area. Pupils will also have a focus on narrative writing. They will study traditional Welsh myths and legends such as the story of Gelert. Using the key features and their creative writing, pupils will write their own Welsh myth.

**Iechyd a Lles /
Health and Well-being**

Pupils will understand the factors that affect physical health and well-being: physical activity, balanced diet, care and hygiene, sleep and protection from infection. In PE pupils will develop their understanding of communication skills when working as part of a team to solve problems. They will also understand that all roles within a team have an equal importance.

Cymraeg / Welsh

The pupils will be learning the Welsh vocabulary to welcome people to various landmarks around Wrexham. They will ask rhetorical questions and simple commands about what to do in and around Wrexham – ewch, dewch, tywydd. Pupils will describe places and persuade people to visit them.

**Mathemateg a Rhifedd /
Mathematics and Numeracy**



This term the pupils will learn about the features of 2D and 3D shapes. They will also be learning about fractions, decimals and percentages. During their trip to Wrexham, pupils will develop their understanding of data collection: planning, conducting and evaluating a real-life survey based on tourism to Wrexham. The pupils will also learn how to use their understanding of time to read bus timetables to plan their trip. They will also use their knowledge of money to cost their transport and spends. During the term, we will be holding an Enterprising / My Money Week. All classes will continue to use TT Rockstars to help improve their rapid recall of multiplication and division facts.

**Gwyddoniaeth a Thechnoleg /
Science and Technology**

During this term, the pupils will focus on how animals survive and adapt to their habitat. We will be learning about the survival of the fittest and food chains within different habitats. The pupils will learn about biomes and how living things within the biome are dependent upon each other. The pupils will be taking part in an 'Exploring Landscapes' Technocamps workshop where they focus on flora and fauna within different environments.

**Addysg Grefyddol /
Religious Education**

RE work will focus on a story of Randalph the Wise remembering the past and about what really matters. Through enquiry, pupils will explore the story of creation through different religious and non-religious viewpoints.

Leisure & Tourism

Y Dyniaethau / Humanities

The area of study is 'Leisure & Tourism'. Pupils will be studying the physical and human features of Wrexham and making comparisons between urban and rural locations. They will undertake a geographical enquiry and use their findings to make recommendations for tourism. The pupils will be given the opportunity to read maps of the local area and use compass directions.

**Y Celfyddydau Mynegiannol /
Expressive Arts**

The pupils will focus on the artwork of local artist, Mikey Jones. They will study Wrexham landmarks and create their own work in his style. During our field trip, we will focus on the work of Liam Stokes-Massey. In music, the pupils will work on composing a piece to accompany their tourism videos.
